RE: OPENING Tuesday June 16, 2020

St. Louis County Public Health has set criteria for the opening of our pool which is considered a Public Water Recreation Facility (PWRP). In response, we have developed the following plan:

Pools will be open to limited numbers of residents and to CURRENT RESIDENTS ONLY. No guests will be allowed to use the pool for the time being.

The larger front pool will be limited to no more than 40 residents at any given time.

The back pool will be limited to no more than 15 residents at any given time.

The wading pool will be limited to no more than two families with no more than two toddlers or babies per family, each occupying one side or end of the pool to maintain at least a 6' distance between families.

Please go on-line to make a reservation for pool time up to 3 days in advance. From your smart phone, tablet or computer, log into <https://woodsmillvillage.funfangle.club>. This will start taking reservation Sunday 6/14 and you will need to set up your personal reservation account as a member. These will be verified and accepted through our leasing office before reservation take effect. E-mail questions to leasingoffice@woodsmillvillage.com

Every person visiting the pool will be required to:

* **ENTER ONLY THROUGH FRONT POOL GATE**

* Sign in and sign out with a date and time, noting name of all family members to allow for any contact tracing; signature also acknowledgement that they are healthy and are entering at their own risk.

* Wear fabric face coverings of your mouth and nose when not in the water or eating, If you do not have a mask or are unwilling to wear a mask you will be asked to leave the facility. Children under the age of 2 are not required to wear a mask. Please leave your mask with your items when entering the pool. Please do not leave the masks next to the pool as they will get wet or contaminated. If masks get wet or soiled you must replace the mask with a clean, dry mask.

* Thoroughly wash hands frequently and make use of hand sanitizer located at dispensers in the pool area,

* **EXIT ONLY** at back pool gate on the west side of the clubhouse garages.

Do not come to pool area if you are symptomatic of COVID-19 or if they have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 14 days. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, new or worsened cough, trouble breathing, new or worsening body aches, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.

No chairs or tables will be provided. You may bring your own chairs, towels, small float devices, and cushions. All personal items must be removed from the pool area when you exit. Any items remaining at the end of the day will be disposed of in the trash.

All people in the pool area will be monitored by a Woodsmill Village Representative. They will have the responsibility of monitoring numbers and social distancing. THEY ARE NOT LIFEGUARDS. Woodsmill Village pools remain "Swim at your Own Risk" pools.

Please follow the designated pathways for navigating in and around the PWRF to maintain social distancing and obey ground markings and signage.

New pool hours are as follow:	Monday	CLOSED

Limit each group size to 6 people or fewer where possible. Members of the same household may be seated together. Non-families should remember to remain 6' apart.

Adult supervision requires you to enforce social distancing rules for any minors in your family.

Handwashing must remain a top priority. Patrons shall be encouraged to wash their hands after using restrooms and prior to eating. Also, please use the hand sanitizer.

Pool hours are subject to change based on the availability of staff to perform the required monitoring of pool attendance as well as weather conditions.

Please watch Facebook or the Woodsmill Village website for any new information. We will post by Friday mid-day any planned changes that will go into effect the following Tuesday along with any updates in requirements from St. Louis County.

Closure - The certified pool operator, manager or designee(s) shall independently close the PWRF any time that any part of the operational plan cannot be accomplished; including, but not limited to, lack of hand-washing materials or facilities, Lack of cooperation from residents, or inadequate number of a certified pool operator or designated attendants to complete the plan. The PWRF can re-open once operators are capable of carrying out all parts of the plan.

REMEMBER, regular Pool Rules are still in effect:

There are three swimming pools provided for Woodsmill Village residents located to the side and behind the Clubhouse and Leasing Office.

*******NOTE: No lifeguards are assigned to these pools. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK *******

Both larger pools have ropes designating deeper water. If you shift these ropes while lap swimming, you must replace them when finished. Diving is not allowed in any of the pools. Please never swim alone. Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. WE WILL SEND THEM HOME OTHERWISE. No glass is allowed in the pool areas, even if you are pouring into plastic cups – if the glass is put into the trash containers, knocks over and breaks around the pool, the pools may require draining and cleaning and obviously closure for several days or more. Please do not use disposable diapers in the pools but anyone needing these should use the swimming pull-ups designed for pool use. Do not allow any climbing on the block walls or the waterfall.

Please remember this is new not only for you, but also for our staff. These are guidelines that were given to us by St. Louis County. We want to be here for you so we must comply in order to remain open and keep everyone safe. We ask for your patience and understanding while we work through any issues that may arise.
